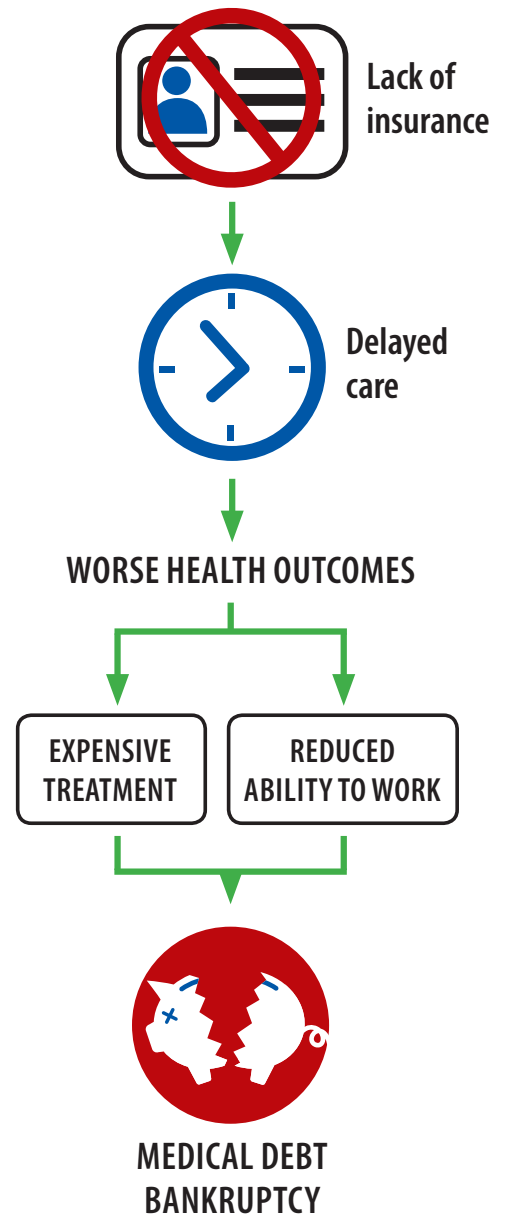


COMMUNITIES OF COLOR EXPERIENCE:

- Higher infant mortality rates
- Lower life expectancy
- Greater rates of substance use
- Higher rates of preventable and chronic conditions like diabetes²

BENEFITS OF MEDICAID EXPANSION TO COMMUNITIES OF COLOR

- Reduce health disparities and work towards race equity in health outcomes for all people³
- Minimize risks for personal bankruptcy and medical debt⁴
- Pave a path for people to access medications, screenings, and treatments rather than rely on the ER³
- Reduce interactions with the criminal justice system through increased access to treatment for SUD and behavioral health⁵
- Help lift people of color out of poverty by ensuring they can have health, then wealth
