# **Ensure Access to Affordable Housing and Health Services**

Rent was unaffordable for 53.8% of renters.

12.5% did not have health insurance.

There are 1,212 residents for every mental health provider.



# Address Structural Barriers to Equality

33.6% of residents are low-income (\$49,200 or less for a family of four).

The richest 5% of households have an average income 22 times greater than the poorest fifth and 5 times the typical household.
