Ensure Access to Affordable Housing and Health Services

Rent was unaffordable for 42.5% of renters.

16.2% did not have health insurance.

There are 739 residents for every mental health provider.



Address Structural Barriers to Equality

41.9% of residents are low-income (\$49,200 or less for a family of four).

The richest 5% of households have an average income 18 times greater than the poorest fifth and 4 times the typical household.
