### Provide Jobs and Opportunities

There were 191 people looking for work compared to 79 job openings.

In the past year, the county's unemployment rate has gone from 4.3% to 4.2%.



Ensure Access to Affordable Housing and Health Services

Rent was unaffordable for 60.7% of renters.

15.7% did not have health insurance.

There are 2,399 residents for every mental health provider.



#### Address Structural Barriers to Equality

48.7% of residents are lowincome (\$49,200 or less for a family of four).

The richest 5% of households have an average income 24 times greater than the poorest fifth and 5 times the typical household.
