# Ensure Access to Affordable Housing and Health Services

Rent was unaffordable for 47.1% of renters.

15.6% did not have health insurance.

There are 482 residents for every mental health provider.



# Address Structural Barriers to Equality

39.4% of residents are low-income (\$49,200 or less for a family of four).

The richest 5% of households have an average income 30 times greater than the poorest fifth and 8 times the typical household.
