In the past year, the county's unemployment rate has gone from 3.5% to 3.2%.



Ensure Access to Affordable Housing and Health Services

Rent was unaffordable for 44.4% of renters.

9.6% did not have health insurance.

There are 359 residents for every mental health provider.



Address Structural Barriers to Equality

24.3% of residents are low-income (\$49,200 or less for a family of four).

The richest 5% of households have an average income 21 times greater than the poorest fifth and 5 times the typical household.
