## Immigrants and the COVID Vaccine: What Do I Need to Know?

This includes people without health insurance. People who do have insurance should bring that information with them.



## Immigrants *can* get the COVID vaccine.

No immigration status or social security number is necessary. You may be asked for your social security number, but you are not required to provide it.

*No ID is required* to get the COVID vaccine.\*



## Your information is kept *confidential*.

Vaccine providers may <u>not</u> share any personal information about you with ICE for immigration enforcement.



Getting the COVID vaccine does not have any negative impact on your chances of getting a green card.

## The COVID vaccine is safe and effective.
