



BACKGROUND

The **Leandro Remedial Plan** (or **Leandro Plan**) addresses the court decision for *Leandro v. State of North Carolina*.

- THE CASE challenged the state to provide all children an adequate public education.
- THE DECISION public education delivery is deficient relative to the state's consitutional standard.
- THE REMEDY lawmakers must bring the public school system into compliance.

WHAT'S IN THE PLAN?

The **Leandro Plan** is a court-ordered schedule of policies to be adopted by the North Carolina legislature over an eight-year period.



The plan addresses the inequity and funding inadequacy preventing student access to opportunities including:

- support staff (school nurses, psychologists etc.)
- qualified educators & leadership academic and language specialists
- safe facilites with modern technology enrichment programs and career training

CALL TO ACTION

- early education (Pre-K)

The North Carolina legislature is responsible for **FULL** implementation and funding of the Leandro Plan -- anything less fails to meet compliance.

Unless we act **NOW**, another generation of children will go without the educational opportunity they are owed.
