### **Medicaid expansion is here!**

You or a loved one may now be eligible for **free and comprehensive health insurance**.



The rules have changed, and many more North Carolinians can sign up for free health insurance through MEDICAID EXPANSION! You may be able to get health insurance through Medicaid even if you didn't qualify before.

### Are you eligible for Medicaid?

Most people can get health insurance through Medicaid if they meet the criteria below. If you were eligible before, you still are. Nothing changes for you.

- You live in North Carolina.
- You are age 19 to 64.
- You are a U.S. citizen. Some non-U.S. citizens can get health insurance through NC Medicaid.
- Your household income fits within the chart at right:

Household Size	2025 Monthly Income*
Single adult	\$1,800 or less
Family of 2	\$2,433 or less
Family of 3	\$3,065 or less
Family of 4	\$3,698 or less
Family of 5	\$4,340 or less




#### What services does Medicaid cover?


Primary care so you can go to a doctor for a check-up or when you are feeling sick

- Hospital services
  - Prenatal, maternity, and postpartum care if you are pregnant and after giving birth
  - Dental, vision, and hearing services
  - Prescription drug benefits
  - Mental health and substance use disorder treatment
- Preventative and wellness services
- Rides to non-emergency medical appointments










# You can sign up for Medicaid anytime of the year!
