completely unnecessary.


Politically, it's based upon unfounded conspiracy theories of widespread non-citizen voter fraud. **Practically**, it's confusing and already causing naturalized immigrants with a constitutional right to vote to question their eligibility to cast a ballot in North Carolina.

The amendment proposes to change the current language *from*:

"every person born in the United States and every person who has been naturalized, 18 years of age and possessing the qualifications set out in this Article, shall be entitled to vote at any election by the people of the State,"

to:

"Only a citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age and possessing the qualifications set out in this Article, shall be entitled to vote at any election by the people of the State."



Constitutional Amendment

Constitutional Amendment to provide that only a citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age and otherwise possessing the qualifications for voting shall be entitled to vote at any election in this State.

WHY VOTE AGAINST:

1. It does not change the voting laws in North Carolina or the United States. State and federal laws already prevent non-citizens from voting in state and federal elections.
2. It is built on anti-immigrant sentiments & rhetoric that are harmful to and exclusive of North Carolina's immigrant communities.
3. Non-citizen voting is extraordinarily rare and the systems currently in place effectively prevent it.
4. It is part of a national trend to further disenfranchise voters, specifically BIPOC and immigrant voters.
