 - Increase protections against HOA foreclosures
 - Impose regulations on Residential wholesalers/
 "We Buy Houses"
 - Address use of eviction records by screening companies

- Its objective is to change local and state policies and practices to make the criminal justice system more fair, from arrest to reentry.






Driving Opportunities
