

AVOID NOTARIO FRAUD

Have you sought legal services from a Notary Public or “Notario Público”?
Did the notary fill out legal forms for you?

YOU MAY HAVE BEEN SCAMMED!

“Notaries public” or “A notario publico”:

- **MAY NOT** recommend immigration forms to fill out immigration paperwork, give legal advice, or complete any legal forms, including Powers of Attorney. Only licensed lawyers can do these things.
- **MAY NOT** charge more than \$10.00 for his notary services. Those that are not lawyers cannot charge **ANYTHING** for immigration services or legal services.



“Notaries are cheaper than lawyers!
And immigration forms or Powers of
Attorney are so easy to fill out,
anyone can do it!”

Be careful! Immigration law is very complicated!
An error can result in deportation, wasting
money, or even an arrest for fraud! And Powers
of Attorney must confirm with state law or they
may not be effective at all.



Get help: law schools, non-profits and some private attorneys are providing powers of attorney or immigration for free or at low cost.

DID YOU KNOW?

- A notary public only has six (6) hours of training after high school
- A true lawyer has to complete seven (7) years of formal education after high school
